

Having an EF will boost your confidence and helps with making critical decisions in your life. It helps with sudden, unexpected situations whether good or bad. Situations like these include:

- 1. Losing your job and having bills to pay.
- 2. Money needed to buy shares in an IPO.
- 3. Tuition fee for career development courses.
- 4. Bills in case of a sickness




How can one say that they are righteous when ill is spoken of his brother or sister. We are shutting out persons who want to enter into the Kingdom.


As we focus on evangelizing let's ask God to strengthen us to do his will.
