THE WORD IN REVIEW

I Am Blessed By God

Sunday September 24, 2023

...he was rich, yet for your sake he became poor, so that you through his poverty might become rich [2 Cor. 8:9].

Terah, Abraham's father had three sons but the Lord called **Abraham** out of them.

...“Go from your country, your people and your father’s household to the land I will show you. “I will make you into a great nation, and I will bless you; I will make your name great, and you will be a blessing. I will bless those who bless you, and whoever curses you I will curse; and all peoples on earth will be blessed through you.” [Gen. 12:1-3]

Thus the covenant blessing of the Lord was released to the generations.

Sarah, Abraham's wife, was barren so she gave her maid, Hagar to Abraham according to the tradition. Hagar conceived and bore him Ishmael [Gen. 16]. Sarah then conceived and had Isaac according to the word of the Lord.

Every male child was entitled to inherit a share of his father’s estate but the firstborn male would receive the family’s name, prestige and a double portion of his father’s wealth. Abraham’s wealth was embedded in the covenant blessing that the Lord had promised him. Once such a blessing is released, it could not be negated.

Though Ishmael was the firstborn, the Lord told Abraham that Isaac, the younger son, would be heir to the covenant blessing [Gen. 21]

Isaac also had two boys (twins). Esau and Jacob. Esau was born first and would have been entitled to the firstborn blessing. However, Isaac was deceived and he blessed Jacob the younger instead.

...and I blessed him—and indeed he will be blessed!” [Gen. 27:33]

Before the boys were born, the Lord told Rebekah that the older will serve the younger.

Jacob had eleven sons. His eldest son, Reuben forfeited his firstborn blessing because he defiled his father's bed and his blessing went to Joseph's two sons, Ephraim and Manasseh. When Joseph presented the boys before their grandfather, Manasseh, the older on the right and Ephraim on the left, Israel (Jacob) crossed hands so that his right hand fell on Ephraim and the left on Manasseh. He told Joseph that the younger would be greater than the older [Gen. 48:19].

Throughout the generations, with all the family crises, errors and acts of bad judgment, the covenant blessing was sustained and the Lord repeatedly took the blessing of the firstborn, and placed it on the younger. After the same pattern, **Jesus, Son of God**, being the firstborn over all creation, God also rejected Him so that the younger (not deserving) could receive His covenant blessing.

God changed the order of things so that we, without having deserved it, could be blessed. And the blessing cannot be negated.

He redeemed us in order that the blessing given to Abraham might come to the Gentiles through Christ Jesus, so that by faith we might receive the promise of the Spirit [Gal. 3:14].

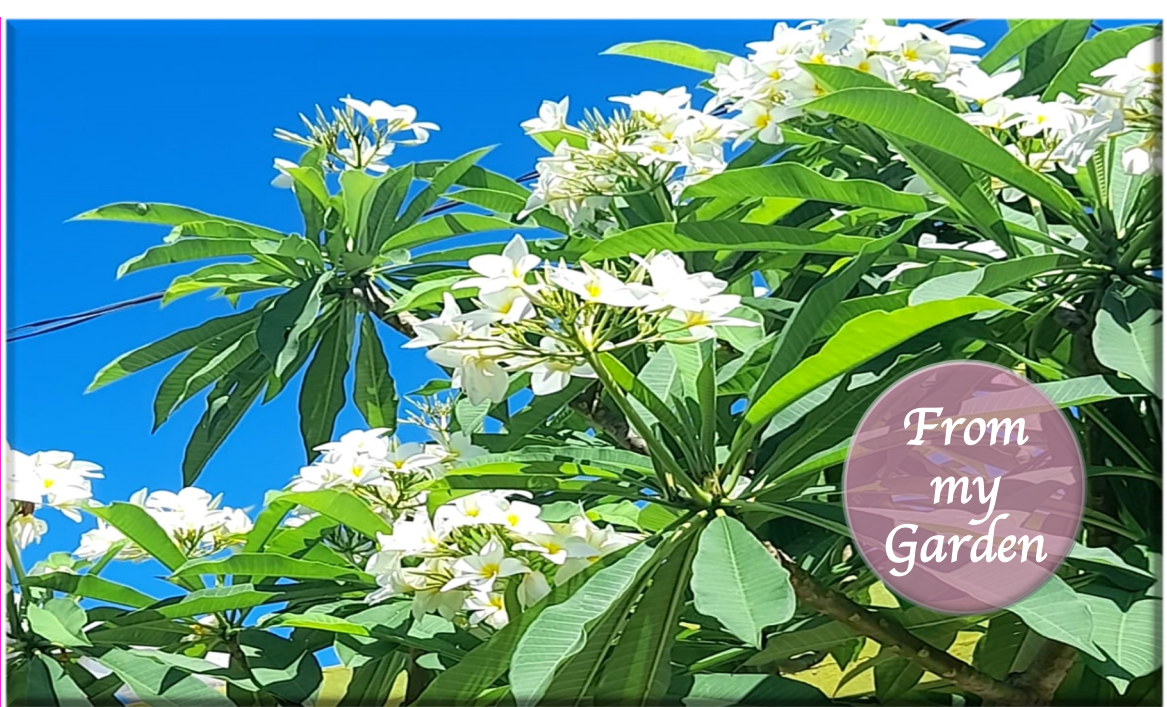

Events of The Patriarchal Age—Isaac to Jacob

It is reported that Lot disappeared into shameful obscurity after his two daughters gave him wine and enticed him into incest. Reference is made later to the evil days that he lived in and God's subsequent judgment [Luke 17:28-32; 2 Pet. 2:7], but no biblical record of his later life. However, Moab's and Ammon's enmity to Israel would be seen in future days.

Abraham was able to see smoke rising out of the devastation of Sodom from the place where he stood before the Lord to intercede [Gen. 19:28].

After these things, his journey took him south to Gerar where he stood before Abimelech and again tried to pass Sarah off as his sister. The Lord swiftly resolved the misunderstanding.

It was very unpleasant for Abimelech and his house but for the Lord's own sake, the purpose on this union was already established. So the heir of the promise was born and the Abrahamic line continued in him [Isaac].

Isaac, now settled at Beersheba. The remainder of his life revolved around the actions of his two sons. **Jacob** and **Esau**.

... "Two nations are in your womb, Two peoples shall be separated from your body; One people shall be stronger than the other, And the older shall serve the younger."
[Gen. 25:23]

Isaac loved Esau, the older of the twins and Sarah loved Jacob [Gen. 25:28].



The Bible

The formative years of the twins were not mentioned in scripture except that they developed personalities that were very different from one another.

The first significant event noted about them was when Esau sold his birthright to his younger brother in exchange for a meal. Whether the boys understood the implications of such a transfer is not fully explained. Nevertheless, we see the sovereign hand of God at work in building the nation of Israel through which all the nations of the earth would be blessed.

Jacob and Esau are not mentioned again until they were middle-aged. When Isaac made plans to bless Esau but Rebekah laid plans to ensure that the blessing would go to Jacob.

Isaac blessed Jacob indeed. Esau arrived on the scene when it was too late. The blessing had already been transferred and could not be voided. In those societies, God would be regarded as a witness to such blessings.

...I have blessed him—and indeed he shall be blessed.” When Esau heard the words of his father, he cried with an exceedingly great and bitter cry, and said to his father, “Bless me—me also, O my father!” But he said, “Your brother came with deceit and has taken away your blessing.” [Gen 27:33-35]

Shortly after, Isaac sent Jacob to Laban in Padan Aram to find a wife and to escape Esau’s wrath.

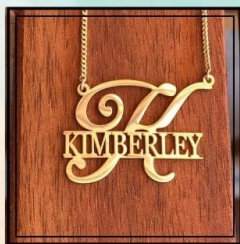

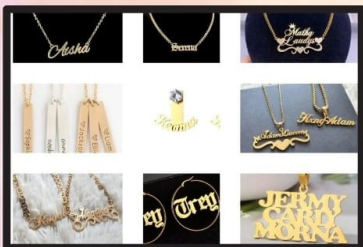
